Staff Expectations

WHAT TEACHING STAFF ARE EXPECTED TO DO

Structure of the work

Where it is possible for the Classteacher we expect teachers to spend an appropriate amount of time planning and resourcing tasks that enables students to continue learning the curriculum in each subject. However, if the classteacher is ill and unable to work our expectation is that parents use links provided to online resources, suggested websites and software programmes such as TT Rockstars.

Teachers, when setting work, are expected to set challenging work for students that is in line with the curriculum plans.

Guidelines for structuring learning activities:

- Depending on the age of the child, paper based or One Note, Tapestry and paper based for EYFS children
- 2. Packs for children will include exercise books, pencil and reading books. Some children will have text books. Children in Year 5 and Year 6 have access to One Note.
- 3. Teachers planning will include activities to reinforce prior learning.
- 4. Set the following daily tasks:
- Maths arithmetic and reasoning
- Reading, including comprehension tasks
- Writing and handwriting
- Spelling, punctuation and grammar
- Times tables TT RockStars
- Other subject areas science, history or geography (this might be reflective of the missed classroom learning). This could include activities from across the curriculum e.g. D&T. Daily focus for example Monday 'Get up and Move' PE. Tuesday 'Thinking about the world we live in' RE etc
- 5. Home learning area on website will be updated with set tasks and signpost parents to useful apps/internet based learning.
- 6. Children's log ins have been sent home, teachers checking that children are accessing these sites
- 7. Work will be collected by the teacher on the return to school.

Pupil Expectations

Pupils are expected to complete all of the work that has been set to the best of their ability and to an expected high standard.

Pupils must complete the set tasks **daily** in order to keep up with their learning.

A record of work is to be kept in the exercise book, One Note and/or worksheet provided.

All work, not already submitted, to the teacher on the recommencement of school.
