Autumn 3 Focus

This terms learning will be focused around "Once Upon a Time" The children will be learning about different traditional tales, looking at similarities and differences between the stories and characters. We will also be learning about Chinese New Year as we continue to explore different celebrations from around the world.



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#### **Phonics**

During this term, we will be move one to phases 3 phonic sounds with the *Little Wandle Letters* and *Sounds Revised* scheme. Your child will continue to come home with a phonics book which will be updated with a practice sheet every time they learn a new sound. #### **Literacy - Writing**

During this term we will be expecting children to come up with their own ideas for their writing.



During our guided writing sessions, children will be encouraged to listen for all sounds they can hear in the words they want to write. They will also be given daily opportunities to do this independently.

Our written work will be linked to the wide range of books that we share as a class, such as 'The Three Little Pigs', 'Three Billy Goats Gruff' and 'The Great Race'.

# **Literacy - Reading**

Your child will continue to take part in 3 reading lessons a week where they will learn how to decode word, read with prosody and develop their comprehension.

Please read the book repeatedly to help your child develop their confidence and fluency. Don't forget to write in their reading records to let us know when they have been reading at home. If you are having any issues with the eBooks, please speak to a member of staff.

Your child will still choose a 'Reading for Pleasure' book to take home at the end of each week. This is a book to be shared with the adults at home. There is no expectation that they can read this book independently.

# <u>Maths</u>

This term we are continuing to look at how numbers are represented. We also include counting strategies to every lesson along with looking at shape, space, measure, addition and subtraction. This term there will be focus on how addition and subtraction can be recorded and develop our understanding of mathematical symbols.



This term, we will also be offering you a chance to come into school and take part in one of our Maths lessons. This will take place on **Friday 20**<sup>th</sup> **January** – More information to follow.

# **Communication and Language**

This term we will be focusing on how to retell a story. We will be encouraging the children to act out the traditional tales we look at, using props and taking on the role of different characters.



We will be learning key phrases from the traditional tales to develop our vocabulary.



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# Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term, we will continue to develop our understanding of our emotions as well as providing the children with plenty of opportunities to work collaboratively



# **Physical Development**

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We will be continuing to develop our fine motor skills through daily dough disco sessions at the start of the day. Alongside this we also have Super Sewing, Drawing Club, Squiggle while you Wiggle and Get Squiggling sessions to strengthen body control, hand grip and pencil control.



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Our PE lessons are still on a Wednesday. Please could all children attend school in their PE kit.

Children need to have an Academy PE t-shirt, shorts or jogging bottoms/leggings depending on the weather and an Academy Jumper. All children must be wearing trainers. Please also ensure they **do not wear any jewellery and that long hair is tied back.** 

### **Understanding the World**

This term we will be exploring seasonal changes as the weather gets colder so the children can observe how winter changes the world around them. We will also be exploring Chinese New Year to compare how people celebrate around the world.



### **Expressive Arts and Design**

We will be making lots of art work that links to our traditional tales, including masks, puppets and building using different materials. The children will also be making Chinese crafts as part of our Chinese New Year learning.



This term we will have a range of role play opportunities for the children to retell the traditional tales we share in class.

# Helping your child learn at home

- <u>Daily</u> reading using your child's school reading book and 'Reading for Pleasure' book.
- Phonics practice using your child's phonics book.
- Encourage your child to practice reading and writing the tricky words that are sent home.
