

# Year 5 Newsletter – Summer 1

## Welcome

Welcome back, we hope you have had a lovely break. This term we have lots of exciting learning to complete. Our main topic for the term is The Tudors. As with last term, our homework will be handed out on a Thursday to be handed in the following Tuesday. As a reminder, children can change their reading book on any day. Reading records will be collected in each Friday and Dojo points will be given out for the number of times children have read to an adult.

## Spelling and Reading

This term we will continue to test spelling on a Tuesday and new spellings will be sent home on this day. In reading we are continuing to work on our inference and explanation skills as well as retrieval. As a reminder, children are expected to log on to Spelling Shed to practise their weekly spellings and books, which match children's reading levels, are on Ebooks. Dojo points are given for children using both these platforms weekly. Our class text for this term is Spymaster, First Blood by Jan Burchett and Sara Vogler.




## Writing

In English this term we will be writing setting and character descriptions, a diary entry in role of a character from our class novel and work relating to Shakespeare's Macbeth. We will be continuing to develop our vocabulary as well as using more advanced punctuation and sentence structures.



## Maths

In maths we will continue to work on decimals and percentages and will look at the relationships between fractions, decimals and percentages. We will then move on to working on area and perimeter and then statistics.



## Science

Our science topic this term is Feel the Force. We will be learning how to measure forces, looking at how different forces work and conducting experiments about different forces.



## Computing

In computing we will be learning how to create our own single player games. We will learn how to design our games, how to input commands into the games and how to input instructions so points can be scored.



## Design Technology

Our DT topic this term is food technology. We will be looking at healthy recipes, taste testing some pasta sauces and then designing and making our own healthy pasta sauce.



## History

Our geography topic this term is the Tudors. We will learn about the Tudor monarchs, focussing on King Henry VIII. We will also learn about significant Tudor explorers, how religion changed in England in the Tudor period and the events of the Spanish Armada. We will be going on a class trip to Warwick Castle as part of this topic.



## Music

In music we will be learning about Motown music. We will learn to perform, Dancing in the Streets.

## PE

This term we go back to outdoor PE lessons on a Monday and Tuesday. This term we will be studying athletics and tennis.

Our topic this term is relationships.



**RE**

Our RE topic this term is Sikhism. We will be asking the question - What is the best way for a Sikh to show commitment to God (Waheguru)?
