Spelling and Reading

This term we will continue to test spelling on a Tuesday and new spellings will be sent home on this day. In reading we are continuing to work on our inference and explanation skills as well as retrieval. As a reminder, children are expected to log on to Spelling Shed to practise their weekly spellings and books, which match children's reading levels, are on Ebooks. Dojo points are given for children using both these platforms weekly.



Writing

In English this term we will be writing balanced arguments, persuasive leaflets and non-chronological reports linked to our science topic.



Maths

In maths this term we will be working on decimals, negative numbers, converting units of measure and volume.



Science

Our science topic this term is meteorology. We will be looking at weather and different weather patterns.



Computing

In computing we will be looking at computer systems, networks and the internet.




Art & Design
