Spring 1 Focus

This terms learning will be all about "Space". The children will learn about our sun and how it warms our planet, how gravity keeps us from falling off the ground, about people who study the stars including Galileo and Caroline Herschel, about astronauts including Mae Jaimeson, about the International Space Station and the planets in our solar system.

We will look at stars and constellations, the Apollo 11 mission to the moon and the Mars 2020 mission that has put a rover on the red planet. The learning this term aims to inspire the children to think beyond their immediate environment and begin to ask scientific questions about what we know and understand about space.

To start of our learning this term, we will be going on a class trip to the Space Centre on Monday 8th January 2024. Please make sure you have completed the consent form on Parent Pay.

<u>Phonics</u>

During this term, some of the children will move on to phases 3 phonic sounds with the *Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised* scheme. Following on from our assessments, some of the children will use this term to recap our Autumn term's learning. Your child will continue to come home with a phonics book which will be updated with a practice sheet every time they learn a new sound. Literacy - Writing

During this term we will be expecting children to come up with their own ideas for their writing.



During our guided writing sessions, children will be encouraged to listen for all sounds they can hear in the words they want to write. They will also be given daily opportunities to do this independently.

Our written work will be linked to the wide range of books that we share as a class, such as 'Astro Girl', 'How to Catch a Star' and 'Zoom to the Moon'.

Literacy - Reading

Your child will continue to take part in 3 reading lessons a week where they will learn how to decode words, read with prosody and develop their comprehension.

Please read the book repeatedly to help your child develop their confidence and fluency. Don't forget to write in their reading

records to let us know when they have been reading at home. If you are having any issues with the eBooks, please speak to a member of staff.

Your child will still choose a 'Reading for Pleasure' book to take home at the end of each week. This is a book to be shared with the adults at home. There is no expectation that they can read this book independently.

<u>Maths</u>

This term we are continuing to look at how numbers are represented. We also include counting strategies to every lesson along with looking at shape, space, measure, addition and subtraction. This term there will be focus on how addition and subtraction can be recorded and develop our understanding of mathematical symbols.



Physical Development

To continue to strengthen our gross and fine motor skills, we have dough disco, Squiggle while you Wiggle and Get Squiggling sessions to strengthen body control, hand grip and pencil control.

Our PE lessons will continue to be on a Friday. Children are to attend school in their PE kit.

Children need to have an Academy PE t-shirt, shorts or jogging bottoms/leggings depending on the weather and an Academy Jumper. All children must be wearing trainers. Please also ensure they do not wear any jewellery and that long hair is tied back.

Understanding the World

This term we will be exploring seasonal changes as the weather gets colder so the children can observe how winter changes the world around them. We will also be exploring Chinese New Year to compare how people celebrate around the world.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be linking all of our Arts and Design activities to our unit of Space. Children will use Papier Mache to make their own planets, as well as creating a whole class display about space. They will also create stars and rockets using a range of materials and will be encouraged to use them in their imaginative play. The children will also be making Chinese crafts as part of our Chinese New Year learning.

This term we will have a range of role play opportunities for the children to explore such as a rocket and the International Space Station.
