

## **Scholastic Book Fair**

Dear Parent/Carer,

Our annual Scholastic Book Fair will be running Monday 11<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2024. Parents are invited to visit the book fair in the school hall from 3pm – 4pm on Monday 11th, Tuesday 12th, Wednesday 13th or Thursday 14th March.



**Each child from Reception Class to Year 6 can choose a free book up to the value of £5.00 from School.**

If they choose a book that costs less than £5.00, please note that no change can be given and the difference in price cannot be transferred towards the cost of another book.

If they choose a book that costs more than £5.00, then parents/carers must pay the extra. For example, a book costs £6.99 – school will pay £5.00 towards it and parent/carers needs to pay the extra £1.99.

All children will also receive a £1.00 World Book Day Token on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March which you can keep hold of and use towards the cost of any book available at the book fair. Alternatively, you can use the token at any participating retailer.

As always, there is also the option to purchase any other books from the book fair if you wish to. These would need to be paid for in full by yourself. You can either pay by cash at the book fair, or there will be a QR code displayed in the hall and on the tables you can scan and pay online. If paying online, you will need to tell a member of staff which book you want to order and the reference number for your online payment.

Children will have the opportunity to browse the books available during the school day. For any parents that are unable to attend the book fair, a member of staff from your child's class will help them choose their free book up to the value of £5.00.

There will be a limited number of copies of each book during the fair. If there are not enough copies, then we will order the extra ones required.


On Thursday 7th March our school will be taking part in a special author visit being facilitated by London based singer-songwriter, author and broadcaster **Sharlene-Monique**. She is best known for singing to 3 billion households with the Kingdom choir for the Royal wedding of prince Harry and Meghan.

Children in Reception to Year 6 will attend an assembly in the afternoon in which they meet Sharlene-Monique, hear about who she is and what she does, and listen to a read aloud of her book A New Life.

There will be an opportunity for the children to purchase their own copy of **A New Life** which can be signed by the author after school from 3.30-4.15pm. Paperback copies will cost £10 and hard back copies will cost £15. These can be paid by cash or card payments will also be accepted on the day directly to Sharlene-Monique.



As well as A New Life, Sharlene-Monique will also be selling her adult book called **31 diamond thoughts** which is £10 to purchase.
